PASTORAL CARE INFORMATION

Baptism: Expectant parents are encouraged to call the Parish Office to register for a three-week session preparation program offered in English or Spanish. Contact the Parish Office to register.

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults): The preparation process for adults who wish to consider becoming Catholic or who wish to complete their Catholic sacramental formation. Contact the Parish Office for information.

Confirmation: Young people wishing to be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit should contact the Youth Ministry Office. Adults should contact the Coordinator of Adult Ministry.

Marriage: Couples planning to marry should contact the Parish Office at least one year prior to a tentative wedding date, which should not be finalized until confirmed with a priest or deacon.

Care of the Sick: Please contact the Parish Center when someone is sick, hospitalized or unable to attend Mass so that arrangements may be made for those who wish to receive Communion and the Anointing of the Sick.

Holy Orders: Young men who wish to find out more about the Priesthood, contact Fr. Bozzelli.

FAITH FORMATION

Religious Education: Grades Pre-K to 5, including specific sacramental preparation for First Penance and First Eucharist.

Youth Ministry: Grades 6 - 12; including specific sacramental preparation for Confirmation.

Adult Enrichment: For adults interested in spiritual development and faith formation. Sessions offered the first and third Sundays of the month in the morning in the Parish Center.
